- 1. Symposia accepted- Deadline for final symposia is May 31st
  - a. Current Advances- 19 speakers, 15 are graduate students, & diverse topics
  - b. Acarological Research Methodology from Lab to Field
  - c. Tick symposium wasn't accepted because it wasn't different enough from other symposium. Only 3 people were signed up anyway. May be able to integrate into the other symposia. Action item: David- see if they want to sign up for the other Emilie's symposium.
  - d. May 17<sup>th</sup> is when everyone was asked to let organizers know of intent to speak. Will let everyone know of final numbers and make final arrangements after this.
  - e. Business meeting- have lunch provided and advertised in advance. Action item: Alex email Becky and see if outsourcing food is permitted or if we have to buy the ESA catered food.
  - f. Keynote speaker- Could suggest for this year even, maybe, but more likely next year. Preference for early career researchers. Names that came up: Ray Fisher, Fred Beaulieu, Alex Revynthi
- MOU- Memorandum of understanding to strengthen ties of ESA and ASA- Don't think
  there will be no major benefit to either society but only unnecessary paperwork. How
  we've been handling it with Current advances and business meeting at ESA and
  recognition of mites as important group is sufficient and good collaboration.
  - Emilie mentioned that volunteering and work involved in putting together symposia is not considered part of ESA volunteer work for that society but only ours.
